Active Duty personnel must be on leave to register for Space-A travel and remain on leave for the duration of the Space-A travel.



Roll Call:

- 1) Roll call will be the last duty day prior to flight beginning around 0900 and concluding at approximately 1500.
- 2) Passengers interested in a flight must indicate interest with the Air Transportation Function by leaving a message at (414)944-8504, between 3 days prior and 0800 the morning of the last duty day prior to flight.
- 3) We will then call you to confirm a spot on the flight the last duty day prior to the flight. You will **not** get a call if you did not make the flight.

***Only those who have expressed interest in a specific flight will be called for that flight**

All personnel must present a valid military ID.

All luggage must be tagged with name, address, and phone #. Sharp or edged object should be left at home (knives, leathermen, letter openers, etc). Luggage is subject to search. Carry-on luggage is subject to 100% inspection. All TSA rules are followed.

Prior to boarding the shuttle to the aircraft all personnel will pass through the metal detector. Any sharp or edged object will be collected by the Passenger Service Agents or added to your checked baggage.

Dress Requirements: Military personnel are authorized to wear civilian clothing. Clothing should be neat, clean and warm enough for in flight operations and safe enough should emergency conditions arise. Additionally, clothing should be appropriate for the occasion and customs of overseas locations. Closed toes shoes are required.
