Please understand that our passenger Agents have no control over the amount of “Space Available” seats or aircraft departure schedules. Both seats and times are subject to last minute changes. We will make every effort to ensure travel opportunities are posted and provide you with a clean, comfortable Terminal while you are waiting for your flight.

Where are we? Naval Station Rota is located on the Atlantic coast of southern Spain, approximately 70 miles from the Strait of Gibraltar. Rota is known as the “Gateway to the Mediterranean.” Rota is located across the bay from the romantic city of Cadiz; the oldest city and shipping port in Spain. Nestled in the Andalucian region, the area is famous for its sherry, flamenco and sevillana dancing, and the breeding of prize horses and fighting bulls. Spain offers a wide variety of historical sights and cultural experiences. We hope you are able to take advantage of our location and enjoy exciting adventures and rewarding travels. Distance to nearby travel destinations (miles) include: El Puerto de Santa Maria 7 (nearest train station), Jerez de la Frontera 15 (nearest commercial airport), Chipiona 10, Cadiz 30, Algeciras 80, Gibraltar 90, Sevilla 80, Ronda 100, Malaga 150, Madrid 400, Barcelona 825. Places to stay. On-base billeting is very limited. Personnel on orders should have reservations prior to arrival. The Navy Gateway Inns and Suites is located in building 39. Off-base hotels have seasonal rates that run from \$60 to \$100 per night. Rooms can be difficult to find in the local area during the summer. On-Base Privileges: Upon arrival, Spanish security will stamp orders, leave papers and issue a limited base pass, allowing access to NAVSTA Rota.

Civilians, dependents and Retirees must have their passport stamped, within 72 hours upon arrival, by Spanish Immigrations Officer at the National Police station located in Rota, Avenida Principes de España 113.

All AMC travelers are permitted to use MWR to include all dining facilities, Golf Course/Pro Shop, Bowling Center, Fitness Center, Housing Pool, Movie Theater, Tennis Courts, Recreation Center, Library, ITT (Information Tickets and Tours. Provides tours for Spain, Portugal, Africa and other countries).

Miscellaneous Items:

Differently able passengers with non-apparent disabilities (such as hearing impairment, asthma, or pacemaker) are advised to notify a passenger service agent of this disability at check-in
Due to safety considerations, the maximum allowable weight for motorized wheelchair movement is 100 pounds. Passengers traveling with a motorized wheelchair must provide assistance and guidance if the wheelchairs battery must be disconnected.
Open toed/open-heeled shoes, narrow base high heels, sandals and flip flops are prohibited on Military Aircraft.
The use of tobacco products is prohibited aboard AMC owned or controlled aircraft.
